Webinar on February 25 @ 5:00 PM

You are invited to join in an illuminating conversation between **Bishop Douglas Fisher**, **Bishop Alan Gates**, and Building Bridges champion, retired Air Force Lieutenant Colonel **John Paradis**, when they will discuss the multifaceted reality of the veteran experience, as well as potential ways to involve the rest of us in bringing greater health to veterans.

The Building Bridges Veteran Initiative (www.buildingbridgesveterans.org/), now expanding into the Diocese of Massachusetts, was founded by the Episcopal Diocese of Western Massachusetts five years ago to create veteran communities which enable the trust and camaraderie inevitably lost when soldiers and military personnel come home. Now nine communities strong, convening weekly and monthly around the luncheon table, Building Bridges has become a critical part of 400 western Massachusetts veterans' lives. One of the tenets of the initiative is that the suffering experienced by veterans is not that of a separate population, but is a reality affecting all of us, and for which we are all responsible.
